Summary

The aim of the doctoral dissertaion "The erosion of the political leadership of Firts Secretaries of the Central Committee of the Polish United Workers' Party", is to analyze a gradual collapse of the political leadership of the personos, who served functions of Firts Secretary of the Central Committee of the Polish United Workers' Party, taking place in the context of the most important internal system mechanisms Regarding this study to the category of internal mechanisms, which included among others prostests and strikes of social masses and the inability to guide the whole party-government apparatus, especially as a result of existing trends to extract factions of the party, and consequently fractional struggles, it should be noted that the erosion of political leadership could take place only if selected people serving as Firts Secretaries of the Party. The analysis, therefore, will be regard only to: Bolesław Bierut (since 1944), Edward Ochab, Władysław Gomułka, Edward Gierek, Wojciech Jaruzelski (until 1990). Serving the function of First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Polish United Worker's Party by Mieczyslaw Rakowski extends beyond the area of research interest of this work because fo the inability of reference to that exercised its function any internal system mechanism. The turn of the 80s and 90s it is to be associated with the collapse of the current system and democratic transformation, whereby these processes were taking place as a result of multidimensional build internal and external conditions, unrelated to the fall of the political leadership Mieczyslaw Rakowski. In relation to other people, one can point to the erosion of their political leadership as a result of the abovementioned mechianisms.

In the context the hypothesis of this dissertaion is as follows: the faster the consensus gets exhausted, the faster the erosion of the political leadership First Secretaries of the Party gets in the following structure: First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Polish United Workers' Party - the ruling elite - the ruling class - social masses. The dissertaion consiss of seven sections: introduction, one theoretical chapter, three chapters discussing relations between First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Polish United Workers' Party and the ruling elite, the ruling elite and the ruling class, the ruling class and social masses, ending and bibliography.

For the most adequate research method was adopted: an analysis of the content and, in addition, a comparative method.

It is assumed that results of this study significantly will be influenced the development of political science, especially in the area so far insufficiently explored, since, as have been established internalsystem mechanisms, which are the source of destruction of the non-democratic system (in this case the political system of Polish People's Republic) so far still not taken any research on identifying the causes of the disintegration of the political leadership secretaries of the Central Committee of the Polish United Worker's Party, to which it causes will not be classified systeminternal mechanisms, representing only a general framework and defining possible context of the process a collapse of the political leadership of these persons. Their importance is secondary rather than conclusive, because they allow you to make a selection of perosns whose a political leadership will be analyzed. In other words, they are the basis for the application of the concept of a leader for above-mentioned Firts Secretaries. Hence the possibility of conducting research in this area will be an inducement to further explore this area of knowledge, for a comprehensive analysis of diverse causes of falls authoritarian and totalitarian regimes.
